GLOUCESTER EVENTS...The Parade of Schooners on August 6 will be led by a familiar vessel. Now named MORNING STAR, she was formerly known to ASA members as BEQUIA WORLD when owned by Richard Dey, and as AGAMEMNON when sailed by Mike Daniel. Her present owner is Captain Scott Edington, a resident of Essex, MA, who sails out of Gloucester. MORNING STAR just completed a 21-day passage from St. Croix to Gloucester. She will be flying an ASA burgee for the parade as Captain Edington is one of the newest ASA members.

THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER will be highlighting the international schooner rendezvous as a prelude to its own Tall Ship Festival the following weekend. Following the Parade of Schooners, the Gloucester city fathers will host a reception for the skippers and crews of the visiting schooners.

To add a truly historical touch to the Gloucester festivities, a match race between a Canadian and American schooner has been proposed. It is reported from a usually reliable source that Henry Endres of SEBIM is more than willing to pit his vessel against any schooner the Americans choose. Anyone interested?
